Justice for Colombia report - Colombia's recent presidential election saw far-right candidate Abelardo de la Espriella unexpectedly take the first round, winning three per cent more than the Historic Pact's Iván Cepeda. This gives the far right the advantage going into the second round on 21 June, and threatens a return to the dark days of repression against trade unions and activists.

For the last decade, the links of solidarity between the National Education Union (NEU) and its sister union ANDEN have been growing stronger. What started with a hug and a handshake in 2016 between the top-level leaders of each union, has now become an interwoven bond between dozens of classroom teachers and union members of both countries. This is thanks to the jointly organised NEU-funded Teacher Exchanges to support Nicaragua's ambitious target of creating generations of students able to speak their mother tongue Spanish alongside English as a Second Language.
