

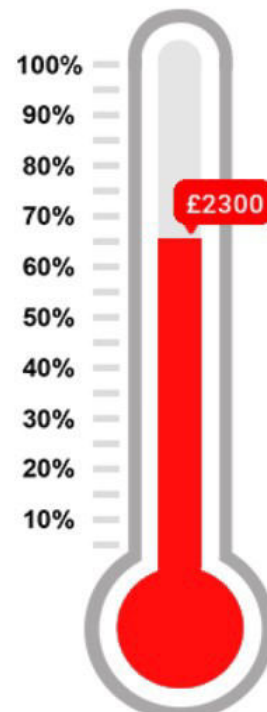

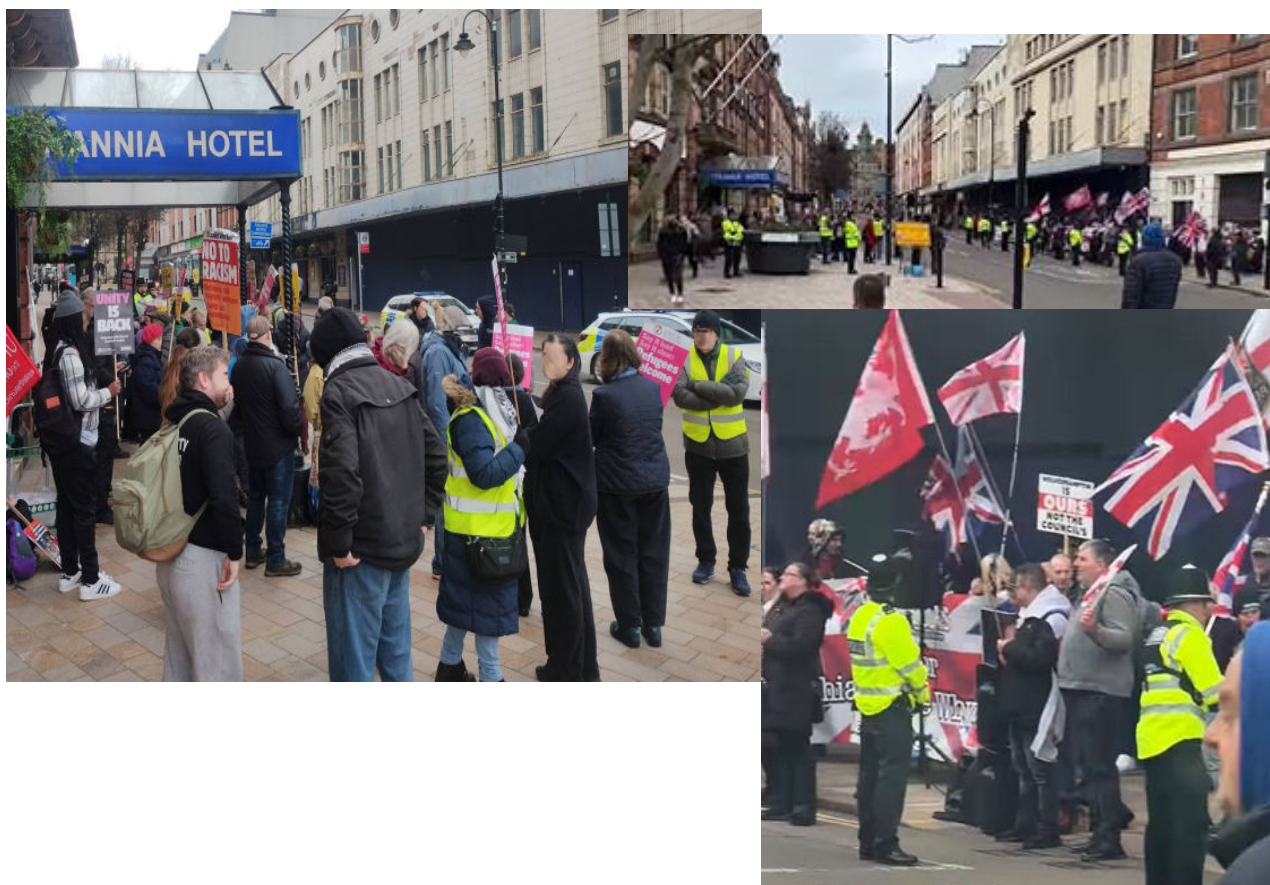
- Over half (54%) of Reform members think that non-white British citizens who were born abroad should be either forcibly removed or encouraged to leave the country.
- One in five (22%) also support this for non-white citizens whose parents were born in the UK.

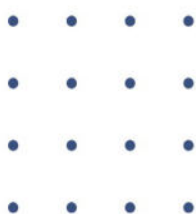
